



IAH Demonstration

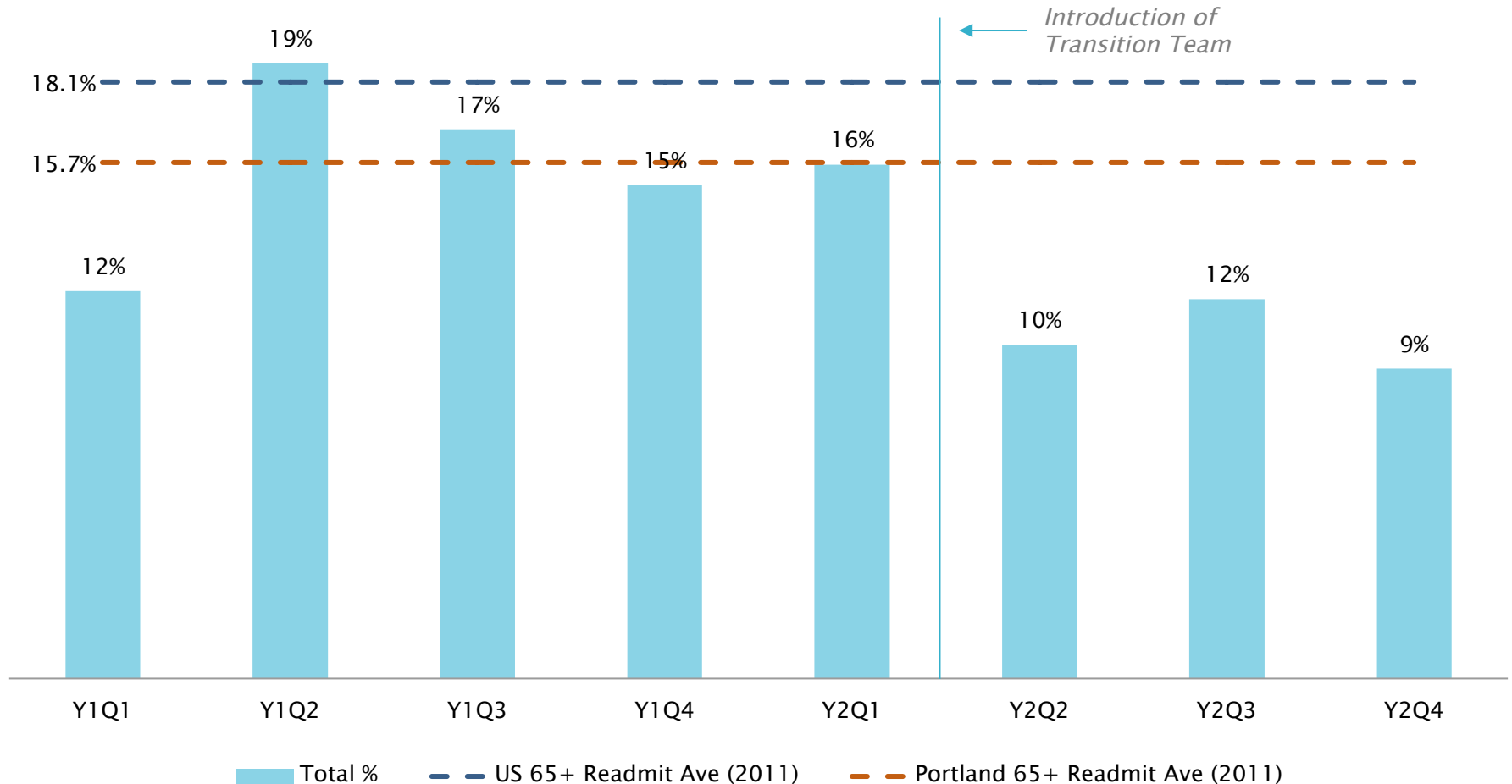
- Housecall Providers is one of 14 practices (and 2 consortia) taking part in the Independence At Home demonstration
 - IAH tests the effectiveness of delivering comprehensive primary care services in the home, while improving care for Medicare beneficiaries with multiple chronic conditions.
 - Housecall Providers found noticeable improvements in the quality of care which led to the creation of the HCP Transition Team.
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HCP Transition Team

- ▶ In late August of 2013, Housecall Providers created a team of three RNs and two social workers to follow hospitalized HCP patients.
- ▶ This new Transition Team provides support for all HCP patients transitioning to and from hospital; from a patient population of 1400.
- ▶ The introduction of the HCP transition team has coincided with a marked reduction in the estimated HCP all-cause 30-day readmission rate
 - Average all-cause readmission rate prior to TT introduction - 16%;
 - Average all-cause readmission rate since TT introduction - 10%
