Health Workers include those workers such as aides and assistants who may provide medical care support to patients.

Mental Health aides/assistants/orderlies fall under the "Psychiatric Aide" occupation. Community Mental Health Social Workers fall under the "Mental Health and Substance Abuse Social Workers" occupation.

Accepted disabling claims are claims, accepted by insurers, arising from occupational injuries or diseases that entitle workers to compensation for disability or death.

Year of the claim is based on the date the Department of Consumer and Business Services received notification that the claim was accepted, which may be different than the date of injury or illness.

Claims are categorized according to the Occupational Injury and Illness Classification System (OIICS) and Standard Occupation Classification (SOC) Manual. SOC codes selected: 211022, 211023, 211093, 211094, 211099, 291141, 311011, 311012, 311013, 311014, 311015, 319092, 319099, 399021.

NEC = Not elsewhere classified

Uns. = Unspecified - information not available to classify at a more detailed level.

Source data are continually updated to be as accurate as possible, so report results may vary over time and may differ from published counts.
